

Stor-Mor Door Options

*The only sure way to keep water completely out of your shed is to install a large cottage or ranch style overhang above your door.

Wood Swing Door w/ Steel Reinforcement

1. 3x6 or 4x6 Standard Shed Door – either is included on every storage building
 2. 3x6'4" or 4x6'4" Taller Shed Door – These provide extra height for your door opening and are an additional upgrade.
 3. 6x6 or 8x6 Double Door – These provide a wider opening for your storage building and are an additional upgrade. One slab of the door is pinned shut with barrel bolts and operates when necessary while the other door is always functional.
 4. 6x6'4" or 8'x6'4" Double Door - These provide a wider and taller opening for your storage building and are an additional upgrade. One slab of the door is pinned shut with barrel bolts and operates when necessary while the other door is always functional.
- All standard Stor-Mor swing doors have steel reinforcement, four heavy duty hinges, lock and key handle, specialized hardware to hold door open as needed and a diamond sill threshold. Hinges can be placed on the right or left.
 - Shed Door Windows can be installed in any of the swing doors to provide light and accent to your shed.
 - Swing Doors are weatherproof for the most part, but not sealed tight as they need room to function around all four sides. Swing doors are mounted from the exterior and are built to handle tough weather.
 - Swing Doors are not typically used if you are planning to sheetrock and finish the interior.



Garden Door

1. 3'x6'4" & 6" x6'4" Garden Door comes standard with 9lite grids. Solid panel doors available upon request.
- A Garden Door is still a shed door and finishes like a shed door on the inside!
 - All Garden Doors are made from fiberglass and provide an energy efficient, long lasting, residential look to your storage shed.
 - They are weatherproof for the most part, but not sealed tight as they need room to function around all four sides. Garden Doors are mounted from the exterior and are built to handle tough weather.
 - They are not designed to be used if you plan to finish the interior of your building with sheetrock.



Steel Entry Door

1. 36"x80" Steel Entry – Comes as a solid six panel. 9lite grids are available for an additional fee.
 2. 72"x82" French Door – Comes with solid glass and grids. A solid six panel is available as well upon special order.
- All pre-hung doors are factory made with steel and fiberglass, solid six panel, include house grade handle, deadbolt, keys and an aluminum threshold.
 - Shed doors are designed to swing out while steel entry doors are designed to swing in. Out swinging steel entry doors can be ordered for an additional fee.
 - All pre-hung doors are mounted inside the wall cavity while shed doors are mounted to the exterior.
 - They are a great option, especially if you are planning to finish the inside of your shed.
 - Unless a large overhang is built above the steel entry door, in the event of heavy rain or high wind, water can get into the building.



Roll Up Door

1. 4'x6'4" & 6'x6'4" Roll Up Door (taller opening available upon request)
- Roll Up Doors are an industrial door, typically used in storage unit yards. The spring inside the door cavity is to assist with raising and lowering the door.
 - Pros: roll up into themselves out of the way, wind will not blow them open or shut, highly secure, padlock can be used to secure them, come with a specially designed sill to eliminate water from entering.
 - Cons: not sealed tight with room around it for wind and bugs, having to bend down and lift it up, having to pull it down to latch it shut.
 - Roll Up Doors are not typically used if you are planning to sheetrock and finish the interior.
 - Doors come pre-finished white, but brown is available upon request.
 - The Roll Up Door needs 13" of clearance from the door opening to the roofline.



Garage Door

1. 8'x7' Garage Door. All sizes and styles available upon request.
- All garage doors are installed after the shed is complete by a garage door company.
 - Garage doors are a great option if you are planning to finish the interior of your storage shed.
 - Typically, garage doors are used on concrete floor sheds. We do not recommend a garage door on sheds with a floor due to moisture working its way into the building. Stor-Mor waives all responsibility of leaky garage doors with a wood floor option.
